Montebello Bus Lines Restores Special Route 60

Montebello, CA – The City Councils of Montebello and Pico Rivera today announced the restoration of Montebello Bus Lines (MBL) Route 60 Monday through Friday service in the City of Pico Rivera. Due to limited and restricted ridership during the COVID-19 pandemic restrictions last year, this route had been suspended from operating. Now that schools and commuters are returning to more normal routines councilmembers from both Montebello and Pico Rivera collaborated on how best to restore rider service to accommodate local transit needs.

“This is yet another example of life returning to normal routine,” said Montebello Mayor Kimberly Cobos-Cawthorne. “We are very pleased we’ve been able to collaborate with our colleagues and counterparts in Pico Rivera in order to re-establish a vital local public transit service.” Mayor Cobos-Cawthorne added that MBL was uniquely positioned to accomplish this given its previous experience with the route.

About MBL Route 60 – the bus line will operate every week, Monday through Friday from the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. from Telegraph Road and Arlington with stops along its route at El Rancho High School, Pico Terminal and the San Gabriel Valley River Parkway.
